

ORDINANCE NO. 491

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE REGULATIONS OF PEDDLERS AND HAWKERS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF RANDOLPH, EXCEPTIONS AND THE ISSUING OF PERMITS AND FEES FOR THE SAME, AND TO REPEAL ANY ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RANDOLPH, CEDAR COUNTY, NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1. To prevent the sale of fraudulent, dangerous and unhealthful goods and services and to protect the public by maintaining records of products sold to persons and companies responsible for such sales, all peddlers and hawkers shall, before doing business within the City of Randolph, make application for and be issued a permit. Application for said permit shall be made to the City Clerk and shall contain all the necessary information and documents required for the protection of residents of the City of Randolph. Any person or persons granted a peddler and hawker permit shall be subject to any fees, occupation taxes and other rules and regulations which the governing board deems appropriate for the purposes stated herein. Any permits so granted shall be subject to revocation for good and sufficient cause by the Mayor.

SECTION 2. Nothing herein shall be construed to apply to any person or persons selling produce raised within the counties of Cedar, Wayne and Pierce or to wholesale salesmen soliciting merchants directly *OR REPRESENTATIVES OF CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS.*

SECTION 3. The applicant shall be granted a ten-day permit of \$10.00 or a one-year permit upon the payment of \$50.00 which permit fee shall be used to cover the cost of processing the application, issuing the permit and enforcing the provisions hereof for the protection of the citizens of the City of Randolph.

SECTION 4. Any person found in violation of this Ordinance shall be determined guilty of a misdemeanor and be fined in an amount not exceeding the sum of \$100.00 for each day during which said person is in violation of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full

force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.



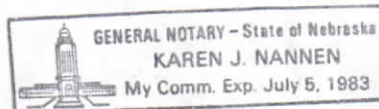

The applicant shall be granted a ten-day permit of \$10.00 or a one-year permit upon the payment of \$50.00 which permit fee shall be used to cover the cost of processing the application, issuing the permit and enforcing the provisions hereof for the protection of the citizens of the City of Randolph.

SECTION 4. Any person found in violation of this Ordinance shall be determined guilty of a misdemeanor or and be fined in an amount not exceeding the sum of \$100.00 for each day during which said person is in violation of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
