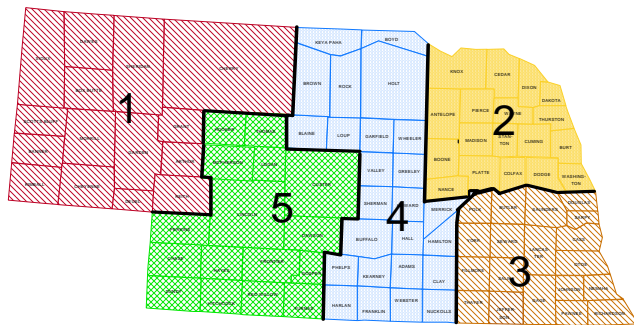

1. A sudden and unexpected increase in the number of animals sick or number of animals dying from an animal disease.
2. Disease symptoms that include vesicles or blisters on the lips, in the mouth, on the teats, and/or on the hairline of the hoof.
3. Abortion in pregnant cows of unknown cause.
4. Central nervous system conditions such as staggering, head tremors, falling, circling, or inability to stand.
5. Unusual infestations of maggots in wounds.
6. Severe respiratory disease that suddenly affects large numbers of animals.
7. Sick or dead animals that may have been exposed to a toxic agent (Crop insecticides, grain treatment chemicals, prairie dog and gopher baits, etc.).
8. Sudden death in animals with bloody drainage coming out nose, mouth and rectum soon after death.
